



The program combines innovative, project-based classes with co-curricular opportunities that allow students to practice and develop a variety of leadership skills. Stroll down hallways at "The 609" on any day to find forensics students cracking a "crime" scene, anatomy and biology students dissecting crawfish, engineering students programming robots, computer science students creating websites, or physics students practicing magic tricks via Newton's Law.

Hands-on, exciting classes are one reason that more than half of IWA graduates pursue STEM majors in colleges. As Physics teacher Dr. Daponte says, "Here at IWA, we don't talk about science; we DO science!"

THE CONFIDENCE AND KNOWLEDGE GAINED HERE PROMPT STUDENTS TO PUSH THEMSELVES INTO MAJORS AND CAREERS THEY NEVER IMAGINED BEFORE IWA.

Likewise, our core subjects like English, History, and World Languages promote lively hands-on learning.

To encourage rigor and even reduce college costs, we offer 18 AP courses, five endorsements, and four Dual Credit courses.

In 2023 and 2024, IWA earned the AP Honor Roll Platinum Recognition and the AP Access Award.

The Heart of Creativity







THE ARTS NOT ONLY HELP STUDENTS DISCOVER THEIR GOD-GIVEN TALENTS, THEY ARE A PLACE WHERE STUDENTS CAN EXPRESS THEMSELVES, FIND JOY, APPRECIATE DIVERSITY, AND PRACTICE COLLABORATION.

Exposure to the arts is critical to the development of each student. From award-winning Fine Arts, Impact Dance, Yearbook, and Choir, Band, and Theatre, IWA's robust arts offerings have existed since the school's earliest years.

Many IWA arts programs are enriched by participation with our "brother" schools. Students from Strake Jesuit and St. Thomas High School can be seen on stage in Falcon Theatre productions. Our Choir shares seasonal concerts with St. Thomas High School's Choir, our students participate in the St. Thomas High School Band, and our Impact Dance team lights up halftime at St. Thomas High School football games.

IWA's athletics program teaches students to be champions on and off the field.

With nine different sports, athletics provides a great way to meet new friends, develop skills, become a leader, and build grit and resilience. Some of our players go on to compete at the next level, and all of our athletes learn how to incorporate wellness and good sportsmanship into their lives.

To provide our athletes with top-notch facilities, and in light of our downtown location, our programs share resources with Rice University, the University of Houston, St. Thomas High School, and Hermann Park Golf Course. Court sports, such as volleyball and basketball, are played in our state-of-the-art gymnasium. Our student-led campus ministry team is guided by our campus minister, but leadership also comes straight from the students. From planning retreats to coordinating mission trips, prayer services, and all-school events, students are in the driver's seat in living out their faith.

Students grow together as a class on retreats each year and develop leadership and character skills through our Service Learning Program. Students can earn up to 75 service hours through campus ministry projects.

Theology classes, taken each year, encourage students to learn about their faith and to embrace incarnational spirituality. The four-year curriculum includes study in scripture, sacramental theology, Catholic social teaching, world religions, morality, and faith formation. IWA WELCOMES STUDENTS OF ALL FAITH TRADITIONS. EVERY STUDENT PARTICIPATES IN LITURGIES, RETREATS, AND PRAYER SERVICES, AS WELL AS SHARING BELIEFS TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT OF MUTUAL RESPECT AND UNDERSTANDING.

IWA's College Counseling Department gets to the heart of the college application process by focusing on the "3 Ps"-passion, purpose, and a plan.

Students work one-on-one with a college counselor throughout their four years to make purposeful course selections and extracurricular decisions.

Students develop academic records and resumes that reflect their unique journeys as learners and leaders. The college counseling program affords opportunities for students to visit colleges, meet with admissions representatives, attend summer programs, and apply for scholarships. Most importantly, Incarnate Word Academy empowers students to lead the way to finding

their right college fit, including the best financial fit. Our class of 2024 closed out the year with a school record of \$15.5 million in scholarships for 70 students.
