NOTES: 1. Transportation needs elementaries to be split on two tiers to balance the number of buses on each tier.

2. Cedar and Hickory being on the same campus will need to be 5 minutes apart.

3. Sycamore needs to be on Tier 2 for buses in the North part to have a school to land at due to timing.

4. Maple and White Oak Early Learning Center (Preschool) will need to be on separate tiers due to limited access.

Start/End Time Scenario A

Strengths	Challenges
Supports brain research on benefits of later school start time for adolescents	Elementary students release earlier (get home before older siblings)
Young students typically wake up earlier and get tired later in the afternoon	For young students with medical challenges, early start time could be challenging
AHS stays consistent – supports extra-curriculars, student jobs, Area 31, etc.	Early start time can be challenging for some younger students (pick up when it is dark)
Willow & Evergreen split between tiers to help traffic; Cedar & Hickory off-set by 5 minutes to help with traffic	MS athletic practices – games have to start at 5:30 pm. Limited gym space for practices and games to occur after school.
All 3 MS on same time – shared sports, collaboration/prof development for teachers	
MS sports can start right after school ends – no need for study tables/supervision while teachers are in meetings after school	
Significant number of students remain on consistent start/end time to current structure (AHS, Middle School, Preschool, Sycamore, majority of 5th grade)	
Older students at home in the morning to help younger students get on bus if needed	
Better supports transportation for shared middle school extra-curriculars since no tier after middle school
