SUMMARY DATA ON CLASS OF 2024

Three hundred ninety-two (392) graduated in the class of 2024. Eighty-two percent are continuing their education in institutions of higher-learning. Of the eighty-two percent, 75% are attending four-year schools and 25% are attending two-year schools.



We are pleased to offer the complete range of IB programming in 9th - 12th grade at Huron High School. These programs are designed to address intellectual, social, emotional and physical well-being of students. For 9^{th} and 10^{th} grade, all Huron students participate in the Middle Years Programme (MYP). For 11th and 12th grade, Huron students have the choice to either the Diploma participate in Programme (DP) or Career-related Programme (CP). There are thirty-three 11th grade full DP students, thirty-eight 12th grade full DP students, twenty-nine 11h grade full CP and nineteen 12th grade full CP students. Huron High School is the only school in Michigan to offer the MYP, DP and CP Programmes.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The year is comprised of 2 semesters, each 18 weeks that average 5 days per week, excluding exams. There are 4 grading periods a year. The school day includes 7 class periods, 50 minutes each.

Approximately 51% of Huron 11th and 12th graders participate in at least one DP course and examination. Our results for May 2024 session awarded the IB Diploma at 68%, the Career-related Certificate at 94% and course averages above 4 at 60% and above 3 at 93%
