Drivers must meet requirements set by the Department of Education, Department of Transportation, the Washington State Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and the District. To train:

- Licensed for at least 5 years to be a driver
- Have had a good driving record for the past 5 years
- Have fingerprints processed and pass a background check
- Drug free; pass a pre-employment drug test and random drug tests throughout your employment
- CDL Medical
- Dependable, always on time, and flexible to the needs of the District and students
- Enjoy working with children

Additional Driver Requirements

- Have a valid CDL license with School Bus endorsement
- First Aid training, agility test
