ASFM's Preschool, encompassing Nursery (3.5 to 4.5 years) and Pre-Kinder (4.5 to 5.5 years), provides a nurturing foundation for our youngest learners. Our developmentally appropriate curriculum focuses on the whole child and integrates physical, socio-emotional, and cognitive growth through engaging, thematic instruction. We foster early literacy skills with a balanced approach, encouraging reading, writing, and oral language and oracy across subjects. Our mathematics program builds understanding through hands-on exploration and discovery through collaboration using manipulatives and real world problemsolving strategies. Students participate daily in either music or movement classes to develop sensorimotor skills and further develop the holistic learning experience.



#### MONTERREY, MEXICO



Monterrey, the capital of Nuevo León, is a dynamic metropolis nestled in northeastern Mexico's mountains. As Mexico's most industrious city and the **wealthiest in Latin America**, it stands as a testament to economic prowess and cultural richness. This thriving city seamlessly blends modern industry with rich traditions, earning its nickname "The Sultan of The North."

The American School Foundation of Monterrey (ASFM) is strategically situated in the upscale neighborhood of Valle Poniente, in the southern part of Monterrey. This prime location offers a serene and secure environment, ideal for educational pursuits. Nestled against the backdrop of the majestic Sierra Madre Oriental mountains, the campus enjoys breathtaking views and a pleasant microclimate. It's conveniently located just a 20-minute drive from downtown Monterrey, providing easy access to the city's vibrant cultural and commercial centers. The school's proximity to major highways ensures seamless connectivity to other parts of the city, including popular residential areas favored by expatriates and local families alike. Nearby, you'll find a mix of modern amenities, including shopping centers, restaurants, and recreational facilities, making it an attractive location for both staff and students. The area surrounding ASFM beautifully balances urban convenience with natural beauty, offering a unique setting that enhances the overall educational experience.

Monterrey's strategic location and infrastructure make it a pivotal hub for air travel, offering excellent connectivity both domestically and internationally. The city is served primarily by Monterrey International Airport (MTY), also known as General Mariano Escobedo International Airport. For domestic travel, frequent direct flights connect Monterrey to major Mexican tourist destinations such as Cancún, Puerto Vallarta, Los Cabos, and Mexico City, typically with flight times under two hours. This makes weekend getaways to beach resorts or cultural hotspots easily accessible. Internationally, Monterrey boasts impressive connections to key North American cities. Direct flights to major U.S. hubs like Houston, Dallas, Atlanta, and Chicago operate daily, with flight times ranging from 2 to 4 hours. Several Canadian cities, including Toronto and Montreal, are also directly accessible. The airport's continued expansion and the city's growing importance in international business have led to an increasing number of routes, enhancing Monterrey's global accessibility and making it an ideal base for both work and exploration.
