





- Faculty average 15.7 years experience at Lemont High School!
- Several teachers are Lemont High School graduates, and even more live in town and have sent (or will send) their children to Lemont High School
- 90 percent hold a Master's Degree or higher

# Academics

- Class of 2024's SAT Composite Average was tops among Southland schools
- SAT Composite Average for:
  - Top 10%-**1432**-95th Percentile
  - Top 20%-**1356**-90th Percentile
  - Top 50%-**1234**-79th Percentile



# Academics

- 2024 AP Exams - 513 students combined for 984 exams - 79% scored 3 or better
- 2025 AP Exams - Anticipating 572 students will take 1,060 exams
- 89% of current seniors are enrolled in a dual credit course



# Academics

- 87% of graduates enroll in college within a year of completing high school
- 91% of LHS graduates who start college return for a second year
- 95.8% of last year's freshmen are “on track” according to ISBE



# Course Placement Process



# Accelerated Placement Act

- Students who EXCEED standards on the most recent state or standardized assessment will be automatically enrolled into the next most rigorous level of course work.
- Automatic enrollment is the practice of assigning students into the next most rigorous level of advanced coursework offered by the district if the student exceeds State standards in English language arts, social science, mathematics, or science on a State assessment administered under 105 ILCS 5/2-3.64a-5.
- These can be honors, dual credit or Advanced Placement courses.



# Placement Process

- As partners in the course registration process, parents/guardians are encouraged to discuss course options as outlined in the Program of Studies.
- Course recommendations and elective selection form will be sent home in early January.
- Parents/guardians are notified of the courses their student has registered for, including those in which their student was automatically placed.
- A parent/guardian whose student was automatically accelerated may decline that placement via Google form.



# Placement Process

- You will receive placement recommendations in January.
- These will be based on the state assessment results from Spring 2024 or Fall 2024 PreACT scores and MAP scores.


