Team Rain teachers Kari Bracy and Amy Johnston were joined by eighth grade students (top to bottom) George Horrigan, Lillian Kloda, Wesley Stringer, Bella Monacelli, and Sarah Winchenbach to speak about the impact of outdoor learning on their seventh grade experience. This invitation to speak was extended by Maine Department of Education Commissioner Pender Makin as part of a ceremony to dedicate a new outdoor learning pavilion for all Maine



students to access on Mackworth Island. Team Rain piloted a fourth quarter interdisciplinary outdoor unit and led summer curriculum planning focused on the integration of outdoor learning after winning a Maine Outdoor Learning Initiative grant from the Maine Department of Education in the 2023-2024 school year.

An excerpt from the Maine Department of Education Newsletter:

"Before last year, I thought that learning was meant for classrooms," George, an eighth-grade student from Scarborough Middle School, said. "I realized how being outside can teach us so much, from hands-on learning to real-life scenarios. The outdoors was a great environment to learn. It provided plenty of fresh air, along with a break from sitting still. When we were outside, I felt happier and had more energy. When we came back inside, I was relaxed, focused, and ready to learn."




News from the SPS Nutrition Department about Nutrislice






