E. <u>Per Pupil Charge.</u> Participating Districts shall pay a per pupil charge (the "Per Pupil Charge") for each resident student which it permits to be enrolled in the Academy at a rate or amount to be set by the Fiscal Agent in connection with annually adopting the operating budget. The Per Pupil Charge shall not exceed the average foundation allowance of all the Participating Districts at a particular Campus, plus an amount not to exceed an additional ten percent of that average without approval by a majority vote of the Superintendents of the Participating Districts for the Campus.
