### NORTHVIEW PATHWAY NIGHT

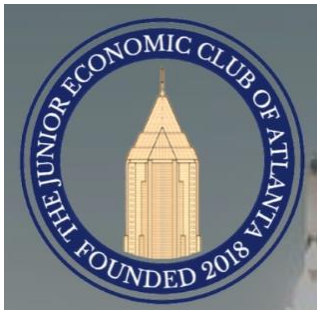
