Dear Students,

It is almost time for the Thanksgiving parade! Unfortunately, the people in charge of blowing up the balloons didn't get enough helium to keep all the balloons in the air. **We need your help!**

Your challenge is to:

- 1) Design a balloon, inspired by a book character, for the parade.
- 2) Create a device to keep your balloon floating in the air.
- 3) Add accessories to your balloon so that it closely resembles your chosen character.
- 4) Be creative and original!

Important Suggested Dates to Help You Stay on Track:

- ☐ Choose your character and start brainstorming a design by Monday, November 18. It may help to draw your design first.
- ☐ Secure all necessary materials by Friday, November 22.
- ☐ Bring your completed Balloon Project into school on Wednesday, November 27.

TIP:

Keep in mind that balloons may deflate if blown up too soon. Therefore. . .

- Plan, organize, and create your accessories ahead of time.
- Assemble your balloon masterpiece as close to the due date as possible.

Suggested Materials:

- 1 or more Balloons
- For accessories: Construction Paper or Oak Tag, ribbon, marker
- To hold up the Balloon: Popsicle Stick(s), Straw(s)
- Scissors, Scotch Tape, Glue
