



**Emmett School District
Superintendent's Report October 14, 2024**

District Updates

- The first phase of our emergency communication platform has been ordered. This will be the installation of a signal repeater station that will allow for consistent communication with Sweet and Ola. The timeline for full implementation is still January 2025.
- Emmett School District and City of Emmett have been working together on a new Memo of Understanding for a full time SRO for our secondary schools. The new memo of understanding will be presented to the Board at the December meeting.
- Emmett School District has a third meeting scheduled with IDT on November 21st here at the District Office. IDT will provide an update on request for lowering of speed limits between Substation and Mill Road.
- Tyler Technologies: The District is still working with Tyler Technologies on determining if the program can meet the specific needs of the Emmett School District.
- HB 521 School Modernization Facility Fund 80% has been transferred to the Emmett School District LGIP account. Approximately \$7.3 million in funds were deposited in October.
- Idaho School Board Association Annual Convention
 - This year the event was held in Boise Idaho.
 - ISBA is the Idaho School District's Association of Schools
 - The Convention is where our local School Boards present Resolutions that are voted on and become the platform for legislations and expectations from our ISBA Executive Officers.
 - Training Opportunities for Public Information Officers, Trustees, Board Clerks, Human Resource, and Superintendents are the focus of the convention.

- Emmett Middle School: With the recognized challenges facing our EMS team the District will begin providing additional support for EMS administrators. Mr. Hyde will support the EMS team by providing office support and mentoring for our EMS administrators.
 - Providing additional support by being present on the EMS campus three days per week. This collaboration with EMS administrators will help provide opportunities for our EMS team to address academic and climate priorities in the building.

District Academics

- November 8th Region Math Center continues to work with our K-8 instructors on mathematics unit studies
 - The Region Math Center Mentors work directly with our K-5 instructors and our 6th-12th grade math teams in creating unit studies
- K-5 teachers also use their Friday professional development time to review data with some grades using part of this time to work on our District Standard Based Report Card pilots.
- Gifted and Talented Program Pilot at Emmett Middle School has started



- EMS will provide an update in December as to the progress of the pilot. Instructional coaches are working to develop ways to expand this program to other grade levels outside of the regular classroom.
- PBIS District and Building Teams continue to work and improve our supports
- District Administrators, Secondary Administrators toured Turning Points Alternative School in the Vallivue School District. We are discussing a possible transition to this type of structure for the 2025-2026 school year. More information will be provided as we develop our plan.

District Maintenance Updates

- Emmett Middle School Annex Building: Initial concern we possible mold in the Art Classroom. Tests have confirmed that it was not mold.
 - Roof of the Annex will need to be replaced
 - Currently soliciting three bids for this project to remove the roofing to the trusses and replace the metal roof with a 30 year asphalt composite shingle.
- Soliciting Bids to place a TPO membrane over the Bus Barn. The retightening of the metal screws and new bushings have not sealed the roof.
- Maintenance will be bringing a proposal to the Board in December to expand our contract with ABM for 2025-2026 school year.
- Request for Qualifications for Design Build Construction and Architecture Teams were completed. Seven Companies submitted their qualifications
