November Transportation Department Update

Key Transportation Highlights:

School Bus Operations

- Regular Bus Routes 29,138 Miles Driven
- 40 Sports/Activity Trips 2,748 Miles
- PR2TA Shuttle 2,355 Miles 12,500 Student Transports
 - EHS & BCHS to PR2TA & Return
- Total Miles Driven: 34,642
- Fall State Submitted Ridership Counts Oct 21-24
 - Total Average Daily Ridership: 2,030 (AM & PM Routes)
 - Average Daily Shuttle Riders (PR2TA & Intra-District): 1,439
 - Total Students Transported on Routes in 4-Day Period: (AM & PM): 8,118
 - Daily Average Miles Driven: 2,006 (Routes & Shuttles)

- Completed State Mandated School Bus Evacuation Drills for all Drivers & Riding Students
- ✓ Completed & Submitted State Mandated Student Rider Counts & Mileage Summaries
- ✓ Initiated Community Radio Interface Architecture Connecting Transportation to Schools & Community Dispatch
- ✓ Prepared Activity Shuttle Van for Use for by District (Mechanical Inspections/Repairs/Cleaned/Titled & Registered)
- Implemented Bussing Shuttle for SpEd Adult Transition Work Release
