Assessments and Data

Students took the SICA and IXL Snapshot and used that data at our October 28, 2024, PD to start the implementation of Weekly Literacy assignments across the curriculum. Below is how the rollout of this looks:

- Teachers assign a weekly article for students to read that connects to their current instructional unit
- Teachers level the article if needed (Khanmigo or OER Project)
- Teachers choose an option from the “Weekly Literacy Menu” for students to interact with the reading
- Teachers use a rubric to score the assignment

- Teachers will share 3 examples of student work (beginning, developing, meeting expectations) in PD presentations
- Teachers will keep a data log of weekly literacy assignment rubric scores
