


Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District October, 2024

Special Education Demographics:

• As of Oct. 8, 2024, the home page of our IEP platform (Edplan) shows 360 students receiving Special Education with an additional 4 Referrals, and 14 Consents for Evaluation.
