Name of Scholarship	Eligibility Criteria
<b>Aaron Nordstrom</b>	This scholarship has been established in honor of Aaron Nordstrom. The scholarship will be awarded to a Jamestown High School senior. The awardee must have played on the Jamestown High School hockey team. Preference will be given to a student continuing hockey at the collegiate level. The institution must be accredited. A minimum GPA of 2.5.
<b>Alberta Martin-Swartz/Jamestown Dollars for Scholars</b>	This scholarship will be awarded annually by the Lincoln Elementary School to a JHS senior who plans to enter the field of teaching education. Preference will be given to students planning on becoming an elementary school or special education teacher. Former Lincoln Elementary School students will also receive preference.
<b>Anne Carlsen Legacy Scholarship: Young Minds, Bright Futures</b>	The Anne Carlsen Legacy Scholarship: Young Minds, Bright Futures will be awarded to a graduating JHS senior pursuing a healthcare career with a focus on pediatrics or an education/teaching career. The awardee must be a child of a current Anne Carlsen employee or a current Anne Carlsen employee. Post-secondary education is required.
<b>Chesterman Communication/Jamestown Dollars for Scholars</b>	This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from JHS who demonstrated exemplary academic performance in communications-related classes and involvement in communications-related extracurricular activities in High School and expressed intent to major in Communications, Marketing, Business, Broadcasting and Advertising at any accredited technical school, college or university.

Special consideration will be given to the individual(s) who has worked and/or volunteered in a related field
<b>Jamestown Dollars for Scholars Service Scholarship</b>	The Jamestown Dollars for Scholars wishes to recognize one JHS senior who have demonstrated outstanding volunteer or community service during the past year. <b>This scholarship will be issued in two payments, 500.00 in the first year of college and 500.00 in the second year of college</b>

<b>Jamestown Educational Association Teacher Education.Jamestown Dollars for Scholars</b>	One scholarship will be given annually by the Jamestown Educational Association to a JHS senior who displays the qualities of character and concern for others and plans to enter the field of education. <b>Preference will be given to a child of a current or former Jamestown School District teacher.</b>
<b>Jamestown Dollars for Scholars/James Vondergeest Memorial</b>	This scholarship is given in memory of James Vondergeest, former assistant superintendent at Jamestown Public Schools. It will be given annually to a Jamestown High School senior planning to enter the field of education
<b>Jerry Meyer/Jamestown Dollars for Scholars</b>	In recognition of the many years of commitment Coach Jerry Meyer gave to JHS and high school boy's basketball programs, the family, friends and previous players of Coach Meyer have established a scholarship to be awarded to a graduating boys basketball player with the highestt GPA. If there in no graduating senior player ont he team the scholarship may be awarded to a senior team manager who has contributed to the Jamestown Community through volunteer activites.
<b>Knights of Columbus</b>	will be awarded to JHS graduating senior. The Student must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher
<b>Leonard J. Haitzsch Memorial</b>	This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Senior from <b>JHS who plan to attend the University of Jamestown.</b> The selection of the student will be based on scholastic promise,citizenship, personality, and seriousness of the purpose as evidenced by academic records and /or recommendation.
<b>Noel Howell FFA</b>	Awarded to a graduating senior from JHS or Blue Jay Academy who has attended the JVCTC and is pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree in the field of Agriculture. A letter of reference from a teacher is required.
<b>Olive B Haitzsch Memorial</b>	This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from JHS attending a <b>four year ND college or university.</b> (excluding University of Jamestown). Award will be based on scholastic promise, citizenship, personality, and seriousness of purpose as evidenced by academic records and/or recommendations
<b>Sarbaum</b>	Will be awarded to a JHS graduating senior planning on attending any post secondary program. The student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5
<b>Sidney and Alberta Holaday Scholarship for Academic Excellence</b>	*Must have the highest ACT test score and highest GPA in the Senior Class

<p><b>Smile Studio, PC Scholarship</b></p>	<p>The Smile Studio, PC scholarship is about recognizing young people who understand the importance work ethic, personal responsibility, delayed gratification, and a positive attitude. These are hardworking students who will keep the lights on, the water running, and take excellent care of people. These are the people who show up early, stay late, and understand the value of a hard day's work. These are the students we want to reward. This scholarship is for those students who are dedicated to helping others, and who are regularly involved in volunteer work and putting the needs of people and community first. After the construction of Dr. Fallgater's new office, the need for students attending school to learn a trade really struck her as a strong need and priority for this scholarship.</p>

<p><b>The Monsignor Jeffery L Wald Scholarhip</b></p>	<p>The Monsignor Jeffery L. Wald Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Jamestown High School senior. The student must have attended St. John's Academy for at least 5 years. The applicant must complete an essay of 300 words or less describing how their education at St. John's Academy impacted their life.</p>
<p><b>The Wildcat Way/Jamestown Dollars for Scholars</b></p>	<p>will be awarded to a Jamestown High School student who completed four years at Gussner Elementary School and successfully graduated from Gussner. The awardee must be attending an accredited higher learning institution</p>
<p><b>Yatskis/Rockwell Collins Scholarship for Science/Math</b></p>	<p>The recipients must plan to attend a university, college, or trade/technical school and major in the field of math or science. Examples include, but are not limited to the following: engineering, computer science, biology, physics, math, pharmacy, electrical technology, nursing, and education degrees in math and science. Preference will be given to students who have taken the most challenging math and science courses at JHS. Although GPA and class rank are considered, they may not be the primary selection factor.</p>
<p><b>Wicklund/Shurr/Jamestown Dollars for Scholars</b></p>	<p>The Wicklund/Shurr/Jamestown Dollars for Scholarship is available to a graduating senior from Jamestown High School who has participated in non-sports co-curricular who also participates in a music related co-curricular. Preference will be given to an individual pursuing a career in music or who has played the flute or a drum majorette.</p>

<b>The Medicine Shoppe</b>	This Scholarship will be awarded a male or female student attending a 2-year or 4-year accredited institution. Student shall have participated in a minimum of 2 years of hockey and/or baseball/softball during high school
<b>Dr. Dawn's Pet Stop</b>	This scholarship will be awarded to a male or female student going into the field of veterinary medicine, Preference will be given to students who have volunteered or interned with Dr. Dawn.

### **Are You Eligible to Apply?**

You must have:

Graduated from a high school in this state, or a high school in a bordering state covered under state law (N.D. C.C. 15.1-29) or Graduated from a Nonpublic high school in a bordering state while residing with a custodial parent in this state, or completed a program of home education under N.D.C.C. 15.1-23 **and**

Completed at least one dual-credit course provided by a NDUS institution while enrolled in high school or program of home education **and**

Be currently enrolled at an institution of higher education in ND **and**

Have completed at least one semester, quarter or term at an institution of higher education in the state.

### **Application Process**

If you meet the eligibility criteria noted above, log into the Dual-Credit Tuition Scholarship website and follow the steps.

You must know your NDUS User ID & password to start the application.

You will be required to attach all required supporting documents to the application.

### **What are the Supporting Documents?**

\*\*Copy of final high school or home school transcript listing the dual credit course(s) completed.

\*\*Copy of the charges incurred for the dual-credit course(s) completed.

\*\*Copy of current college transcript showing completion of at least one semester, quarter or term of post-secondary enrollment.

#### **How Much is the Scholarship?**

\*\*Lifetime maximum is \$750

\*\*May not exceed 50% of the cost of the dual-course(s)

\*\* May not exceed tuition & fees for the semester, quarter, or term the scholarship applies.

#### **Where can I use the Scholarship?**

The scholarship may be used for post-secondary enrollment at a ND state public, private, tribal or proprietary institution.

#### **When will I receive the scholarship?**

Generally, after you are awarded by NDUS disbursements will be made in the next Semester, quarter or term you are enrolled at a qualifying ND institution.
