- Reviewing Outcomes-Based Measures Report
 - ECHS Status in not in danger.
 - The Access portion, TABS is not meeting access, including emergent bilingual..
 - The attainment field overlaps with the work in TCC Ed Partnerships. Completing Core 42 and Post Secondary Degree. Why is Postsecondary Degree higher than Completing Core by graduation. Is it b/c students are taking stats? Question from Mr. Wooddell, think data is reported directly by TCC. Dr. McGowan says perhaps Higher Education Coordinating board might compile and send to TEA... and send to advising to deal with discrepancy. Does post secondary degree also mean certificate? – matches with Tammy's numbers for Associate Degree.
 - Kudos to Attainment measure, likely will go down in some b/c of TSI situations.
- Testing
 - There was success in TSI testing in September, around 50 kids tested, then more kids tested in October and November.. and more students in January (9th graders)
 - Update from Dr. McGowan: TABS can request boot camp from learning commons before they're testing for TSI (ex. Other FWISD school is having a bootcamp in November). Perhaps the students who were right on the border of passing, might be beneficial for those students.
 - 9th graders PSAT on Oct 15th. 10th and 11th graders on the Oct 16th (big group). Can Dr. Davis alert professors? Morning only, student out by afternoon.
 - Friday November 8th test date for ACT, might not be impactful much to Dual Credit.
- Recruiting
 - Recruiting season is very different this year, Mr. Wooddell is not going to the Middle School. Transportation is difficult for the district. Encourage more students from Wyatt and Dunbar for example to stay in feeder. For some of the middle school it works well going to middle school promotion. Students taken to auditorium to receive information, feeder school gets precedence in these presentations.
 - November 9th --- Choices Expo
- TCC "Clinic"
 - Update from Dr. McGowan –things Ed Partnerships can do in Spring.. get students applied and tested before Summer.. clinic with incoming students day where we have them all in Action Suite.. Advising, Application, SAR to do that all before the students to leave. Wooddell is interested, but transportation can be an issue – if you can get transit not from Fort Worth ISD.. Estimated time for this event is: 10:30AM -2PM.. may not test, but student can do Pre-Assessment (Wooddell/Asbury mentioned).. get handful that we know are coming already, before they leave in Summer .When does that work for TABS (testing is nightmare in April/May). Way to weave around Spring Break that'd be great. 75% roster by March.
 - Is there an issue if the students don't end up in the program and go through this clinic event? No.
 - March 11th SAT, week of MARCH 24th might be good. March 28th as a possibility for this

- event as a FRIDAY (for CLINIC)
 - End of 5th six week is 1st week of April, might be challenging. TELPAS ends on March 28th but might not be everyone.
 - FRIDAY APRIL 11th is another possibility
- Questions about TCC Professors/Attendance
 - SPCH 1311 50008 , Darrell Bartell, 4 drops, and 2 today 10/9/2024
 - Speech and Humanities not taking work seriously, alert if there are any issues, what ways can TABS support students. Maybe professor? Can let TABS know if there are problems/not showing up.
 - Humanities professor lets students know beforehand that LATE WORK IS NOT ACCEPTED.
 - A few professor don't put grades in until end of semester. Professors don't have to input grades.
- Update on Summer Appeals: Asbury thinks they went through, that somebody said they went through, on grades updated from F to W, though Asbury hasn't seen it.
 - Latika Can go see on Advisement Super Screen, or to contact Gina regarding it.
- Request for Summer
 - Dr. McGowan said that Dr. Jackson made it clear that for next summer, students need to communicate with instructor and drop the class, change the way they enroll students. If taking as Dual Credit going to have to be put in 84 SECTION at Connect -- to let instructor know who is dual credit. Making a section for a dual credit students.. students wont be able to sign up for 86 .. For in person classes, will have to come through Ed Partnerships, [this means: request cross listed sections, as already done for fall and spring, sections for summer will be requested in same way...it might be easier to send those sections to Dr. Davis.. there will be a section of TABS students (even if in gen pop) for payment purposes; Does Asbury need this ahead of time?? For students at TABS taking classes not a TR, what will happen?; regarding sections assigned to dual credit on Connect during the Summer --- how is this working? , students like flexibility.. might not choose those assigned, students will like to shop for professors.] now that classes are free, taking a lot of courses and not getting credit at HS. Any approved dual credit course will need their own section. And good to know ahead of time, so ISDs can pay for the book. ANY STUDENT that is taking class concurrently, if FAST eligible don't have to pay for the books, if ISD doesn't either.. student will have to pay for the book.
 - Not seen in Manual : Advisement piece. Dual enrollment is the last place it will roll out. Still have Dover/Erneisha Gibson.. if students want to be advised those two are assigned advisors. [advisement piece still until fall 2025] ;PSAT students should not have hold to register for Spring, should be able to register for ENGL 1302, if in ENGL 1301.
- SAR on October 11th. Several classes still don't have professors/classes
- Budget
 - That TCC has requested. Student facing events still can provide food.. non student facing events.. BIOLOGY supplies will still go through Ed Partnerships office.
 - Ed Partnerships , Castleberry and Responsive Ed. – Budget is not increasing. One of these ECHS will be on campus. We will have to buy stoles for PTECH. Castleberry ECHS at their high school. Both Castleberry and Responsive Ed will be phased in.
