During this second quarter of the year, we will be focusing on schoolwide attendance. Our goal for attendance is 96% schoolwide. On average Lincoln Elementary has 35-50 absences a day. This is a VERY high number of students out a day. Our goal is to have less and less absences a day. For a student to have 96% attendance for the year, they cannot miss more than 9 days for the whole school year. That is no more than 1 day a month. Please do all you can to help support your child in coming to school on time every day. If your child is absent for any length of time, please call the office so the absence can be excused. The office number is 209-953-8651.

We encourage parents to continue to look at the student planners daily (grades 2-6). Every teacher will write homework in their planner daily. This will assist in knowing what your child is expected to do each day.

Lost and Found is a constant issue on our campus. When you send lunch boxes, instruments, jackets, sweaters, water bottles to school with your child, we encourage you to clearly label these items. When there are student names on them, it is much easier to get the items back to the owner.
