RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Demonstrates safe practices, by utilizing proper body mechanics, adhering to universal precautions, and maintaining environmental safety.
- Interacts and provides services to participants, families and team members in a professional manner (i.e. encourage participation in conversation and activities). Communicates observations to team members.
- Other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- HHA or CNA certification preferred and at some locations is required.
- Bilingual ability REQUIRED for specific assignments: Cantonese, Mandarin, Spanish, Farsi, Hindi, or Punjabi.
- Interest, demonstrated ability and/or experience in working with the elderly.
- Ability to work independently and as part of interdisciplinary team.
- Must be flexible to work assigned shifts in center and/or private homes.
- Physical activities require the ability to stoop, reach, stand, walk, push, pull, lift, grasp, talk, hear, and repetitive motion of the wrist and hands.
- Physical requirement: visual acuity and the ability to lift/move up to 75 lbs occasionally and up to 50 lbs frequently.
