



Your staying on-track checklist

Senior year

Aug-Sept

- Plan for college admissions
 - Meet with admissions representatives. Many will come to your school.
 - Secure recommendation letters from teachers and your counselor.
 - Work on application essays if required by your college choices.
 - Review and schedule application deadlines for schools where you want to apply
 - Use your AZCIS account to keep track of all the work.

- Continue your scholarship search at tuitionfundingsources.com. See the guidance page of the Combs High School website for additional resources.

- Get your federal aid eligibility estimate with the FAFSA4caster at fafsa.gov

- Compare estimated college costs and aid availability of your top colleges with the Net price Calculator (NPC) on each college and university's website.

October

- Create your Federal Student aid (FSA) ID at fsaid.ed.gov
- Complete your FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 every year you plan to attend college at fafsa.ed.gov
- Research if your college requires additional financial aid application and note specific deadlines for completion

Nov- January

- Complete applications
- Request your high school send transcripts to the colleges and universities to which you've applied, adhering to the requirements of each school. Bring an addressed, stamped envelope to Gina Campos when requesting official transcripts.
- Ensure all information is correct when you receive your Student aid, if needed
