

Job Title: **Lifeguard** FLSA Status: Part-time Non – Exempt Reports to: Aquatics Director

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Lifeguard monitors the pool area, providing a safe experience for members, participants, volunteers, and staff.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Basic life support or professional rescuer CPR/AED, first aid, and emergency oxygen administration certifications and child abuse prevention training within 30 days of hire date
- 2. YMCA Lifeguard certification or approved lifeguard certification
- 3. Patience and the ability to effectively communicate

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Actively scan the pool, looking for hazards and monitoring the safety of swimmers
- Conduct swim tests with young swimmers
- Adheres to program standards, including safety and cleanliness standards, and ensures consistency with evidence-based practices
- Attends staff meetings and trainings
- Follows YMCA policies and procedures, including those related to medical and disciplinary situations, child abuse prevention, and emergencies
- Other duties and responsibilities assigned by supervisor

YMCA COMPETENCIES (Leader):

<u>Mission Advancement</u>: Accepts and demonstrates the Ys values. Demonstrates a desire to serve others and fulfill community needs. Recruits volunteers and builds effective, supportive working relationships with them. Supports fund-raising.

<u>Collaboration</u>: Works effectively with people of different backgrounds, abilities, opinions, and perceptions. Builds rapport and relates well to others. Seeks first to understand the other person's point of view, and remains calm in challenging situations. Listens for understanding and meaning; speaks and writes effectively. Takes initiative to assist in developing others.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Lift equipment and a small- to average-size child.
- Remain in the pool area at all times.
- Remain alert, with no lapses of consciousness, in a warm environment with air temperatures of 80 degrees or higher.
- Adequate ability to hear noises and distinguish distress signals.
- Ability to continuously scan all areas of the pool with clear vision.
- Support child or adult body weight in the water.
- Remain in water ranging from 80–90 degrees for one to four hours.
- Communicate verbally, including projecting voice across distance, in normal and loud situations.
