

# General Service Technician

## Job Description

This entry level position provides you with the knowledge you need to build a promising career in the Tire & Automotive Service Business; many of our Store Managers, Auto Technicians and Corporate staff began their careers in this position.

Is required frequently throughout the day; servicing vehicle undercarriages, changing oil, stocking inventory, and many other activities.

### Climbing

Is required frequently throughout the day; stocking/pulling inventory, accessing vehicles on the alignment rack, maintaining shop equipment, and many other activities.
