- * Maintain a good working relationship with all employees and management.
- * Treat customers' cars in a professional manner.
- * Immediately upon receiving a new vehicle review parts received for correctness with the Parts Manager. Notify the Production Manager immediately of any parts that will delay the repair.
- * Be prepared to commit to a completion time with the Loaction Manager or Production Manager
- * Record on your time card the actual hours spent on each vehicle for job costing purposes.
- * Clean work area and tools at the end of each day.
- * Report broken/missing tools or equipment to the Location Manager & Production Manager.
