StudentAid.gov account
(students and contributors must
each have their own account)



Records of your assets, including any child
support received; current balances of cash,
savings, and checking accounts; and net
worth of investments, businesses, and farms



Your Social Security number
(unless you are a citizen of the
Freely Associated States)



Your contributor's information, including
their name, date of birth, Social Security
number (if they have one), and email address



Your 2023 tax records



The list of schools you're applying to
(if you're a high school senior) or your
current school's name
