MAS Parking Lot Drop Off

We remind all parents and those who may be dropping off students at MAS of a few traffic regulations. If you are dropping your child off in the

MAS parking lot using a car, there is only one entrance and one exit to and from the MAS lot. The entrance is from Fairway and the exit is on to Maywood Avenue. Please enter the parking lot from Fairway and make an immediate right hand turn. Please pull up as far as you can and drop the child off in the parking lot, who will then make his/her way to the courtyard for line up. Please proceed to exit on to Maywood Avenue and make a right only out of the parking lot. Please do not come into the

MAS lot off of Fairway and instead of making an immediate right, continue straight to the building, drop off and then back out of the lot faced with oncoming traffic as well as staff and students who are walking. Fairway is an entrance only, not an exit. Fairway itself is also not a drop off, but instead a path into the lot for drop off. Lastly, please do not use the roadway in front of the school with the diagonal parking spots as a cut through or drop off/pick up. All of the aforementioned are protocols in place to keep everyone safe and we respectfully ask that you abide by them vigilantly.
