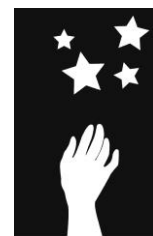

Scholarship History: Gerald “Jerry” Jurgens of Davenport was a longtime sports editor at the Quad City Times. He was a graduate of Davenport High School (DHS). He covered Quad City sports for almost 50 years. Mr. Jurgens passed away in 1996 at age 84.

Eligibility: There are two scholarships; one for a male Central High School athlete and one for a female Central High School athlete.

Requirements: Financial need will be given high consideration.

Deadline & Application:

There is no application process. The students will be nominated by coaches and selected by a faculty committee of coaches and the Athletic Director.

Award: This endowed scholarship of \$1,500 per student is non-renewable and available for one year only. They will be presented at the awards ceremony at Central High School.

Selection Committee: Applications will be reviewed and the winner selected by the faculty committee of coaches and the Athletic Director at Central High School.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
