PROGRAM DETAILS

- LA-HIP is a yearlong paid internship for rising seniors in the greater Los Angeles area.
- Participants complete a 7-week biomedical summer research training and internship with a faculty member at The Saban Research Institute of Children's Hospital Los Angeles.
- Students participate in SAT preparation courses, academic enrichment workshops, as well as a yearlong college counseling program.
- Students receive a stipend, Metro card, and meals from the hospital cafeteria.

Application opens: November 4, 2024

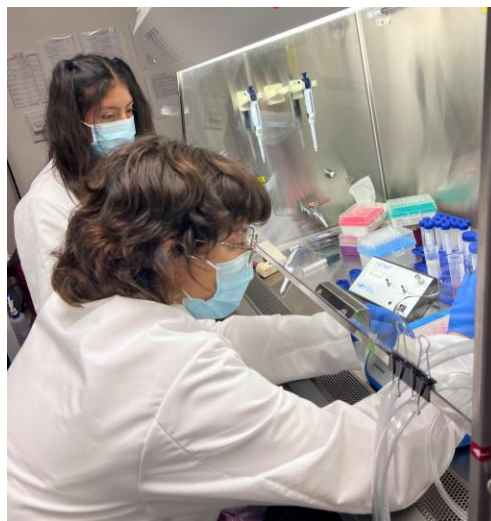
