

Kyrene schools offer nutritious meals at a low cost. Families seeking reduced-price or free meals must <u>submit an application</u> for assistance or visit <u>kyrene.org/foodservices</u> for more information.

Kyrene uses an online system for managing school meal accounts. If you do not already have an account, please visit the payment portal below to register. Meal account balances can be checked at any time through LinqConnect. Cash and checks made payable to Kyrene School District are accepted at school sites as well.

Additionally, Kyrene meal prices will remain the same as the 2023-2024 school year. Regular meal prices: Lunch-\$3.00; Breakfast-\$1.70

Student Messages and Deliveries:

In an attempt to preserve instructional time, messages and deliveries for students will be held in the office and an email will be sent alerting the teacher that it is there. Teachers will send the student down during a break in instruction. If you have a change in transportation for your child, please send a note ahead of time with your child or, for last minute changes, contact the Colina office *PRIOR* to 1:45 pm.

Bus Information:

Kyrene is proud to provide transportation for students in an environment that is safe, courteous, and on time. Be sure to review the <u>Bus Rules</u> and expectations as well as our video reviewing seat belt usage during the bus ride.

Note: Even if your child rode the bus in the past, please check the online transportation portal to verify eligibility and bus stop locations!

As a reminder, kindergartners will not be released from the bus without a parent or guardian to pick them up.

Happy Fall! I continue to go into classrooms discussing conflict resolution using 1 2 3.....Peace, Begins with Me. Students are learning the three steps important is solving problems with one another:

- 1. Be calm and ready to listen
- 2. Talk it out. Make sure you are listening to understand the other person's point of view.
- 3. Come up with a solution that works for both of you

Information about Non-School Days

- 1. Registration: Registration must be completed online at www.kyrene.org/CommunityEd (click log in/register button). Registrations are only complete once Non-Schools Day requests are approved and payment is received.
- Payment: Acceptable forms of payment include Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, EFT- Electronic Fund Transfer.
- Cancellations: In the event that a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, families will be notified at least five business days before the program start date and will receive a full refund in the amount paid per cancelled date per child enrolled. If a family needs to cancel the registration, full refunds are issued for cancellations received six business days prior to the start of program.

Full refunds minus \$10 are issued for cancellations made within five days of the program start date (Refunds are on a per child/per day basis). Refunds are not issued after the start date of each program. Teacher days are considered part of Fall & Spring Break.
