 - Proposed budget reduced from **\$500** to **\$300**.
 - Need to recruit volunteers and finalize flyer distribution (two weeks prior).
- Jessie is currently working with Tina from CGB regarding a possible grade-specific event there bowling
- December event will be the “Parents’ Night Out”
 - Fifth graders will volunteer, with activities like crafts and games.
 - Estimated fundraising goal: **\$400** (20 families at \$20 each).
 - Venue options: school’s community room and lunchroom.
 - Further details to be finalized based on volunteer availability and date choice.
