The OVSD Board of Trustees meeting originally approved for December 10, 2024, has been rescheduled for Tuesday, December 17, 2024. This date change ensures compliance with Education Code 5017, which requires that individuals elected at a regular biennial governing board member election hold office for a term of four years, commencing on the second Friday in December following the election.
