Dear Challenge Families,

We are rapidly approaching the end of the school year and all library materials are due by May 14th, 2021. If your student would like to see which books they still have checked out, they can log into their library account from home.

- Click "Log In" at the top of the Challenge Library page https://chsd.ent.sirsi.net/client/en_US/CHALLENGE WEB/
- Enter your User name (this is your Active Directory name or your email without the "@cherrycreekschools.org") and your Password.
- Once you are logged in, click on "My Account" at the top of the page.
- The tabs on your account will allow you to see which books are checked out to you, renew books, place and edit holds (only available if your account is not blocked), and check to see if you have any fines for lost or damaged books.
- Fines for lost books can be paid online on the Challenge School website https://cherrycreek.revtrak.net/middle-schools/chl/chl-library/
