News from the Cafeteria



Welcome back! We are using a new and more efficient system this year, Titan Family Connect. You may download the app and select, "Family Portal" to set up an account. You will be able to look at the daily menus, add money to your child's account, set spending limits and purchase restrictions to name a few. If you prefer to send money with your student, lunch money will be collected as the students enter the building. If sending cash with your student, seal it in an envelope or ziplock bag clearly marked with the student's first and last name. Checks do not need to be in an envelope, but please write the student's name in the memo section. You may use one check for multiple students.
