<p><b>Principal</b></p>	<p>Ryan Silva Principal Silva thanked the PTCO for a fantastic After-Prom event. Some schools are discontinuing After-Prom. Prom of 2025 will be held the weekend before exams because of limited venues that can accommodate Creek and because of AP testing. Seniors' exam schedules will allow them to take their first exam at 1:10 on the Monday after Prom. Many students took the SAT but some parents accidentally opted out. Information about the exam schedule is in the Bear Facts and online. Many seniors have gotten final college acceptance decisions. Rising Juniors and Seniors have created their class schedules for 2024-2025. There were 15 job openings at Creek for 2024-2025 and 13 have been filled. Senior checkout will take place in the gym. Seniors must have paid all their fees and the counselors will make sure that all class requirements have been fulfilled. DECA went to the national championship and took second place. "Chicago," the musical presented this spring, has been nominated for 13 Bobby G awards. The long-range planning committee is considering designs for the new buildings. The Board of Education will decide whether to call for a bond and budget. Ground could be broken in spring of 2025 at the earliest. One reason for the new construction is that there are mold issues. The school leadership is coming up with a plan to address the mold issues before school starts.</p>
