Evening CNA class at CCIC!

When: -Class will begin Oct. 21, 2024 & end Dec. 16, 2024.

-The class will meet Mon, Tue, Wed, & TH from 4-7:30pm. (No class on November 27-29)

-You will have a break from 6:00PM to 6:20 so please feel free to bring food. We will have a microwave for your use.

-There will also be 16 hours of clinicals in a health care setting in December or January.

Where: Classes will be at Cherry Creek Innovation Campus, 8000 S. Chambers Road, Centennial, CO.

Who: Open to everyone age 17 and up (including adults!). Students **do not** need to live in the Cherry Creek School District boundaries.

How much: Payment will be **due on the first day of class!**

Cost: \$1,250.00 (\$1,000 scholarship available for current High School students)

(Fee includes: Book/Workbooks, Background check/drug test, CCIC Uniform, Basic Life Support/CPR)

-Cash, Check, and Credit Card accepted. If paying with cash, please bring the exact amount!

Transportation: Students will be responsible for their own transportation for both class and clinicals. If students get picked up, they need to be picked up promptly from class at 7:30 pm each night.

Clinicals: In addition to class, there will be 16 hours of clinicals—broken into 2 shifts that will take place in December or January. Your instructor will tell you those dates and location.

Course Description: The course will measure the student's learning and understanding of CNA theory/concepts, skills, and ability to apply the essential skills through practical applications. Competency evaluation (skills) is conducted in a simulated lab as well as in a clinical learning environment. The course is designed to guide students through learning and skill modules. This is a State approved program and students must meet all the course requirements to be eligible for the CNA state exam as well as the minimum hours of direct instruction, attendance is of utmost importance. **A cumulative passing grade of 70%, proficient score of 80% or higher on the final NNAAP skills competency, and 80% or higher on the final written exam and completion of 16 hours of a clinical learning experience.**

Certification: **Colorado State Nurse Aide Certification NNAAP® Exam (Written and Skills)**

**** Note:** Participation in CNA Clinicals requires students to provide documentation of active BLS CPR certification; cleared background check, drug screen, and TB screening; Up-to-date immunization records with Chickenpox/Varivax, Tetanus, MMR, Hepatitis B vaccinations. Optional but recommended vaccinations include seasonal influenza and COVID-19.
