
Winter Coat Giveaway

Attention Third and Fourth Grade Parents: OST Parent Information Night

In the Spring, 3rd and 4th grade students are required to take the OST (Ohio State Tests) in both Language Arts and Math.

Since these are critical tests for our students, we are holding an OST parent informational night on Thursday, November 14th from 4:00-5:00 pm.

Your child's teacher will show you what your child will be tested on, and give your ideas on how your can support your child through the process and get them ready for the test in the Spring.

At the end of the teacher portion of the program, I will meet with Third grade parents in the Media Center to review and discuss the requirements of the Third Grade Guarantee portion of the OST. According to the state of Ohio, students must pass this portion of the test in order to be promoted to the Fourth grade.

Your child's teacher will also be sending information home on this event.


