On August 12th, the CCSD Board of Education unanimously voted to put a mill and bond measure on the November 5, 2024 ballot for CCSD residents. For both measures, residents would pay less than \$3 a month for each \$100,000 of property value.

Overview of 2024 Mill & Bond Package

- Additional security staff and safety upgrades to school buildings
- Expanded access to in-demand, career pathways at sites throughout the district including the Cherry Creek Innovation Campus
- Recruit, develop, and retain high-quality teachers to maintain small class sizes
- Additional mental health and whole wellbeing support to prepare students for their next stage of life
- Renovations to athletic facilities on the east side of the district
- Begin to rebuild some of our oldest campuses:
 - Holly Hills (1958) / Holly Ridge (1962)
 - Overland High School (1978) / Prairie Middle School (1977)
 - Smoky Hill High School (1975) / Laredo Middle School (1974)
 - Cherry Creek High School (1953) / Campus Middle School (1971) / Belleview Elementary School (1954)
- Address \$300+ million in maintenance needs across 65 schools

Estimated Timeline

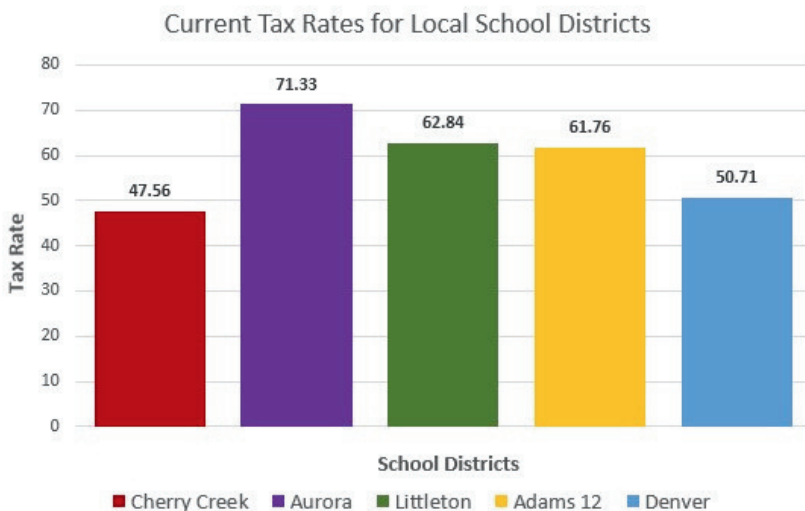
- Concept plan complete; in design phase
