

Semi-Annual Bullying and Harassment Incident Report Summary

Pursuant to House Bill 276, Ohio School Districts are required to semiannually post the number of reported bullying and harassment incidents that occur throughout their district.

The Ohio Department of Education defines bullying and/or harassment as: “Any intentional written, verbal, graphic or physical act that a student or group of students exhibited toward another particular student more than once and the behavior both: causes mental or physical harm to the other student; and is sufficiently severe, persistent or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening or abusive educational environment for the other student.”

Warren County Career Center Board Policy 5517.01: *At least semi-annually, the Superintendent shall provide to the President of the Board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on the District website (if one exists). The list shall be limited to the number of verified acts of harassment, intimidation, and/or bullying, whether in the classroom, on school property, to and from school, or at school- sponsored events.*

Allegations of criminal misconduct and suspected child abuse will be reported to the appropriate law enforcement agency and/or to Child Protective Services in accordance with the statute. District personnel shall cooperate with investigations by such agencies.
