WHAT IS AN ECHS SCHOOL?

As stipulated by the Texas Education Agency, ECHS schools are open-enrollment high schools that allow students least likely to attend college an opportunity to receive both a high school diploma and either an associate degree or at least 60 credit hours toward a baccalaureate degree. ECHS Schools enroll historically underserved students, target at-risk and economically disadvantaged students, provide dual credit at no cost, offer rigorous instruction, provide academic and social support services to help students succeed, provide students with highly personalized attention and intend to increase college readiness.
