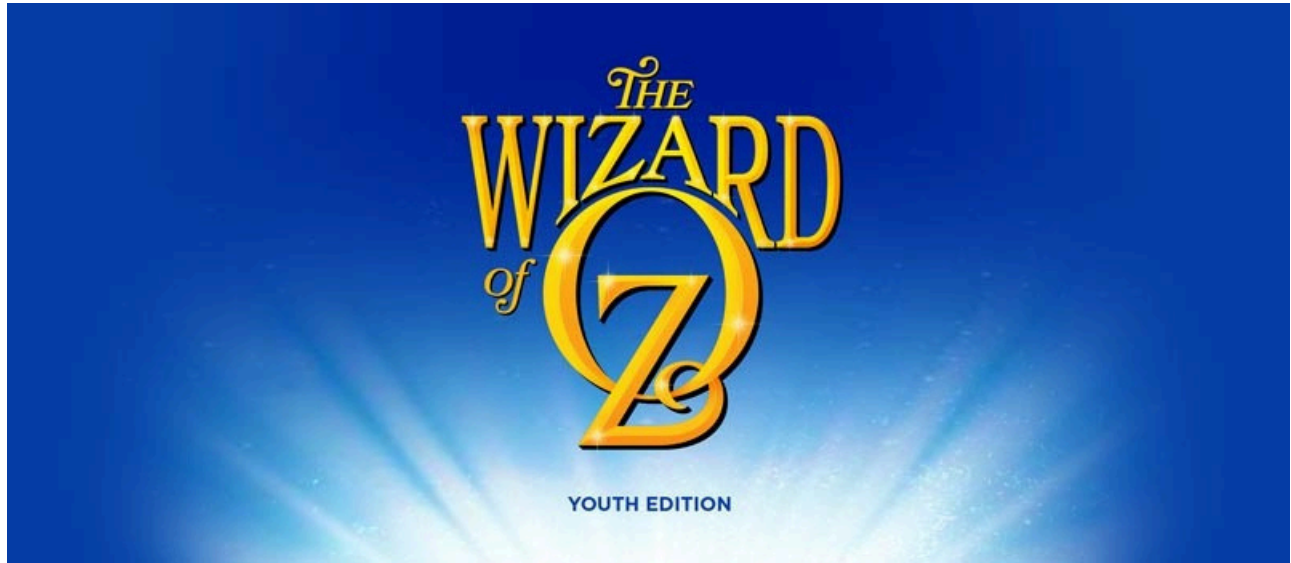


Athletics and Activities
