

Pulling your College Application Together - collegeboard.com

- Narrow your list of colleges between 5 and 10 and review it with your counselor. Get an application and financial aid information from each. Visit as many as possible.
- Make a master calendar and note:
 - Test dates, fees, and deadlines

 - ⇒ Required financial aid applications and their deadlines
 - Due dates for recommendations, transcripts, and other necessary materials
- Ask for recommendations. Give each person your resume or Letter of Recommendation form, located in the Career and Information Center; a stamped, self addressed envelope, if necessary, and any other required forms.
- Write application essays and ask a teacher, the writing center, parents, or friends to read your first draft.
- Most school's priority deadlines are in November!

IMPORTANT Information about requesting transcripts and SAT/ACT Scores

Sending SAT/ACT scores to colleges - Most colleges and universities want your test scores sent **ONLY** from the test companies and no longer accept them from high schools. Decide what colleges you would like your test scores sent to and use your **one time only** free request option on your test registration. Sending your scores later is timely and costly.

Requesting Transcripts from BLHS – Order them online on the website. Plan ahead-it takes 48 hours to process your request.

SAT Opportunities:

Take a practice SAT on paper to simulate the test day experience. After you've finished, score your test using your phone and the free mobile app. "Daily practice for the New SAT, or print the resources that come with each test to score them by hand. 2024 Smart Choices Scholarship Program

Applications due March 14th, 2025

Now accepting applications for the 2024 <u>Gesa Credit Union</u>, <u>Dairy Farmers of Washington</u>, <u>Les Schwab Tires</u> Smart Choices Scholarship Program which will award three (3) \$5,000 scholarships and 12 \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors from WIAA member high schools for excellence in athletics/activities, academics, leadership and community service throughout their high school careers.

Applicants are required to fill out an

<u>2025 SMART CHOICES APPLICATION</u> that includes an essay question. Judging is based on the following criteria:

- Athletic/Activity Excellence (30%)
- Academic Achievement (30%)
- Leadership (20%)
- Citizenship/Community Service (10%)
- Originality/Creativity of the Essay (5%)
- Financial Need (5%)

Interested in attending PLU?

Here are a few scholarships that they are offering.

1. The <u>Nurse and Educator Dependent Commitment</u> began last year and it commits that "If your parent/legal guardian is a nurse or K-12 educator, at least **HALF** of your PLU tuition will be covered by PLU-funded scholarships and grants."

We use the term educator loosely so this does not mean only teachers. Their parents could be a bus driver, work in the library, etc. Their full-time employer just needs to be a school district or private school! Students can fill out an interest <u>form here</u>.

2. The <u>Alumni Referral Scholarship</u> is so easy! If a PLU Alumni (friend, grandparent, teacher, counselor, sibling, etc.) fills out the referral form by **December 1st** of the student's Senior year, they will receive a \$500 per year scholarship. Please forward this on to any Lutes you might

have on staff at your school or any students interested in PLU - the form takes about a minute to fill out!

- 3. The <u>Visit Scholarship</u> is back! We are fully open for campus visits, including many Saturdays this fall. Your students are so close to campus so a short drive and 90 minutes of their time means \$1,000 *per year* if they attend PLU.
