e. <u>Contact tracing</u> in combination with <u>isolation</u> and <u>quarantine</u> , in collaboration with the State and local health departments; f. <u>Diagnostic</u> and screening testing;	The district will coordinate with the DOH on requirements for contact tracing. The district will utilize data gather during the previous SY to determine appropriate contract tracing and quarantining. We do not have this capability. If the district were to receive test kits, students with symptoms would be tested to verify COVID 19 status.
g. Efforts to provide <u>vaccinations to school communities</u> ; h. Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies; and	Vaccinations were available to the community and those that wanted a vaccine were able to receive it. The same will be true for students if it is approved for younger age groups. Any necessary accommodations will be addressed through the Special Education Director.
i. Coordination with state and local health officials.	All coordination with health agencies will be done through the school nurse.


