



LASSITER EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL

Política de admisión a Lassiter Early College High School

Gracias por su interés en Lassiter Early College High School, una asociación del Distrito Escolar Independiente de Dallas y El Centro College. El objetivo de Lassiter Early College High School es apoyar a los estudiantes que están decididos a tener éxito académicamente para que puedan comenzar la universidad con éxito mientras aún están en la escuela secundaria.

Los procesos de reclutamiento e inscripción de Lassiter Early College High School deben identificar, reclutar e inscribir a las subpoblaciones de estudiantes en riesgo según lo define el Sistema de Gestión de Información de Educación Pública (PEIMS), incluidos, entre otros, los estudiantes con dominio limitado del inglés, los estudiantes con discapacidades o los estudiantes que no hayan aprobado una evaluación administrada establecida. Las decisiones de inscripción no se basarán en los puntajes de las evaluaciones estatales, el historial disciplinario, la recomendación del maestro, los ensayos de los padres o estudiantes, el promedio mínimo de calificaciones (GPA) u otros criterios que creen barreras para la inscripción de los estudiantes.

Lassiter Early College High School identificará, reclutará e inscribirá a subpoblaciones (además de aquellas que están en riesgo según lo define PEIMS) que históricamente están subrepresentadas en los cursos universitarios (por ejemplo, estudiantes universitarios de primera generación, estudiantes de bajo nivel socioeconómico, afroamericanos, hispanos, nativos americanos). La información recopilada en esta solicitud no se utilizará para aceptar o rechazar estudiantes.

Los estudiantes de Lassiter obtendrán créditos de secundaria correspondientes a un semestre cada nueve semanas y se espera que comiencen las clases universitarias en el noveno grado. El objetivo de los estudiantes de Lassiter debe ser avanzar hacia la obtención de créditos universitarios que conduzcan a un título de asociado o créditos para transferirse a una universidad de cuatro años.

Los estudiantes de Lassiter tienen la libertad que implica asistir a la escuela en un campus universitario en el centro de Dallas. Esto significa que se espera que actúen de manera responsable y muestren la madurez necesaria para interactuar con diversos grupos de adultos en un campus universitario en todo momento. La autogestión y la automotivación son cualidades esenciales de los estudiantes exitosos de Lassiter. El principal indicador de éxito en Lassiter es el deseo de asistir a la escuela y obtener un título de asociado.

- **Informe de Asistencia:** debe mostrar la asistencia desde agosto hasta la fecha del año en curso.
- **Examen TSI:** TSI es un examen preparado para la universidad, los estudiantes serán evaluados en lectura, escritura y matemáticas.
