
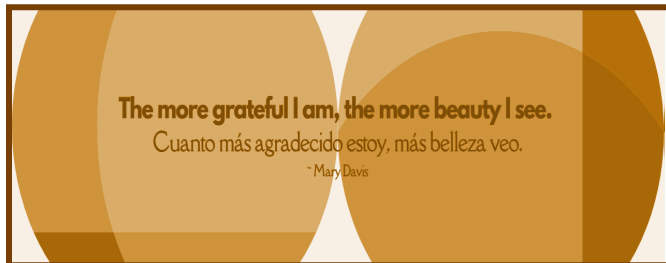

The ASVAB test will be administered at Craig High School on Tuesday, November 19th.

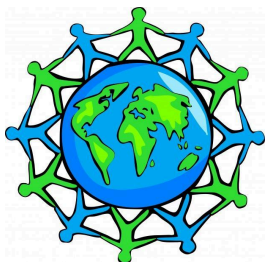
The ASVAB test has the best Career Exploration Program available and it is useful to all students,

The ASVAB test is also used as the military entrance exam, scores are not shared with recruiters. Test is free of charge for 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students.

Sign-up for the free test and career matchmaker program in the Student Services Office ASAP as space is limited. If you have further questions, see Mr. Watson in Student Services.

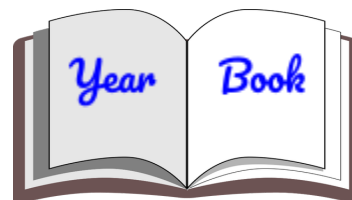
Host Family Needed for a Student from the Netherlands!

- Come to a complete STOP at stop signs from the parking lot before turning onto S Randall Ave.



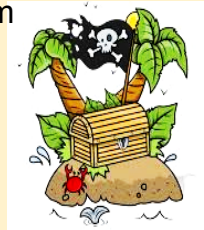
Yes, parking tickets will be issued to those without a parking permit. If you need a parking permit, please see Kelly in the AP Office for details.
