#### **Second Quarter Progress Report Grades**

Second quarter progress report grades will be available on your student's Aeries Portal Saturday morning, November 16.

To view progress report grades, you must be on the **web version** of the portal. Quarter grades cannot be seen in the Aeries app. On the web portal, select the Grades tab at the top of the screen, then select Grades from the dropdown menu.

This is the last progress report prior to semester grades. Semester grades are the only grades that appear on transcripts. This is a good time to work with your students to make sure that they are headed into finals with the strongest grades possible.

If you have questions about a student's progress in a class, please contact the teacher directly.

#### **Grand Opening of CURA Contemporary**


