GOAL AREA 1: ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Math:

By Spring of 2025, 66% of K-1 students will achieve typical or aggressive growth on the early Math assessments. And 80% of grades 2-5 will achieve aggressive or typical growth on the aMath Assessment.

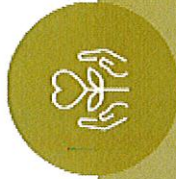
By Spring of 2025, K-1 students 52% of students will make typical or aggressive growth on the early Reading assessment and 80% of 2-5 students will make typical or aggressive growth.

Support for American Indian Students

- 80% of American Indian students will make typical or aggressive growth on their aReading test. 80% of American Indian students will make typical or aggressive growth on their aMath assessment

Academic Strategy:

- Professional Learning Community focused on Tier 1 instruction



GOAL AREA 2: STUDENT WELL-BEING

- By Spring of 2025, students receiving special education services will attend school 90% of the time.

Student Well-Being Strategy:

GOAL AREA 3: EFFECTIVE STAFF

- The 5E Collaborative Teachers essential will increase from a present level of 62 % to 70 % by June 2025.
