

## NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

- A. Nonresident students enrolled in the District at the time of adoption of Policy 3141 will be allowed to remain enrolled in the district until such time they either graduate or enroll in another school district.
- B. The District shall make every effort to meet the following optimum enrollment standards in all grades throughout the District and it shall be determined that a financial hardship exists if class sizes exceed the maximum identified numbers.

A Combination Classroom is defined as two distinct grade levels and curriculums being taught by one employee in the same classroom.
