Dear County Office of Education Chief Business Officials:

## **2023–24 Fourth Quarter Lottery Apportionment**

The State Controller's Office (SCO) distributed the 2023–24 fourth quarter Lottery apportionment on September 30, 2024. The total apportioned to county offices of education, school districts, and charter schools is \$364,330,284.54. Local educational agencies (LEAs) will receive \$177,676,165.52 or \$31.53 (\$31.534346662) per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for the unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$186,654,119.02 or \$33.13 (\$33.127773015) per unit of ADA for the Proposition 20 lottery apportionment this quarter.

A final lottery revenue adjustment is included in this fourth quarter apportionment. The adjustment reflects additional 2022–23 lottery revenue that is available for distribution. Each year, the California State Lottery withholds a portion of its revenues until after the audit of its year-end financial statements. The additional revenue released for 2022–23 totaled \$35,140,944.00. Of this amount, \$2.36 (\$2.363909599) per ADA is unrestricted lottery funding and \$2.60 (\$2.600079583) per ADA is Proposition 20 lottery funding.
