- whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certification through which state qualifications were waived
- what undergraduate or graduate degrees does the teacher hold, including graduate certificates, additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration.

You may also ask whether your child receives help from a paraprofessional. If your child receives this assistance, we can provide you with information about the paraprofessional's qualifications.

Our staff is committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking he/she needs to succeed in school and beyond. That commitment includes ensuring that all our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled.
