Purpose of The Safety & Security Committee

- To discuss safety-related issues in the district
 - To get feedback from stakeholders on the direction of our safety and security practices
 - To maintain compliance with SB11/TEC 37.109
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Senate Bill 11

TEC 37.109

The committee shall:

- Have required members:
 - Parents (2)
 - Teacher
 - School Board Members
 - President and one other representative
 - Superintendent
 - Local PD representative
 - City or county emergency management representative
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The Committee Shall:

Participate in the development and implementation of the district's emergency plans

Provide, periodically to the board of trustees and district administration, recommendations to update the district's Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)

The Committee Shall:

Supply information required for the completion of safety and security audit, safety and security audit report, or any other report required to be submitted to the TxSSC

Review each report the district submits to the TxSSC

Consult with local law enforcement agencies on how to increase their presence near district campuses

The Committee Shall:

Select locations for bleeding control stations in schools

Meet publicly at least once a semester and during the summer

Take training on Psychological First Aid.

Details of Psychological First Aid Training

- **Guidance on responding to disaster, violence, or terrorism events**
- **Practical assistance to meet immediate needs and concerns, reduce distress, and foster adaptive coping in the wake of a disaster.**
- **In-depth information about each of the eight core actions and accompanying handouts for administrators, school staff, educators, students, and parents and caregivers**

Psychological First Aid Training Options

- **Online Training Option** available through The Nations Child Traumatic Stress Network (NCTSN)
- **In-person Training Option** available through Region 13 ESC
 - Sign-up through E-Campus
- Upon completion, turn certificate in to Stacie Seveska

Sentinel

- **IDA** - Intruder Detection Audits
 - **DVA** - District Vulnerability Assessment
 - **TA&T** - Technical Assistance & Training
 - **BTA** - Behavioral Threat Assessment
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IDA - Intruder Detection Audits

- Conducted annually at all campuses
- Supported by optional Door Sweep Tool
- Can be delegated to a single role or multiple roles

DVA - District Vulnerability Assessment

- Conducted randomly on a 4-year cycle
- Include Rubric and Resources
- Supported by Document Repository and District Calendar

TA&T - Technical Assistance & Training

- Centralized repository for resources
- Will continue to add more resources throughout the year
- TEA guidance videos and webinars coming soon

BTA - Behavioral Threat Assessment

- Pilot application opens September 1
- Supported with BTA Manual and Field Guide
- Standardized online instrument

Summer Safety Updates/News

- Safety AP Meeting (August 9) - Review safety requirements and ensure compliance
- Texas State School Safety Center Summer Conference presentation - District drug-prevention-awareness efforts
 - Planning for Drug Awareness training this year
- GISD applied for the SVPP COPS Safety and Security Grant, which could provide up to \$500,000 in additional safety-related funding

HB 3 UPDATE

- Signed into law June 14, 2023
- Highlights of new requirements for campuses



- Window Film
 - Fencing
 - Secured Entry Vestibules
 - Exterior Door requirements
 - District-established procedures for students to report concerning behaviors
 - Silent Panic Alert Technology
 - Additional Emergency Operating Plan requirements
 - Armed, qualified security officer at each campus
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Updates and Progress on HB 3 Requirements

- New Building Safety Standards complete or in progress at each campus
- See Something, Say Something and Stay Safe implemented on all campuses
- SPAT implemented on all campuses along with Emergency Management System
- Additional EOP Requirements submitted and approved
- Armed Security Officer:
 - Research completed
 - Hiring Process created
 - TCOLE Training attended
 - Final placement of hired marshals in progress
