SUBJECT: 2023-24 Fourth QUARTER LOTTERY APPORTIONMENT

The 2023-24 Fourth Quarter Lottery Apportionment was distributed by the State Controller’s Office and deposited into the districts' accounts on September 30, 2024. The total amount apportioned to K-12 school districts, charter schools, community colleges and county offices of education is \$31.53 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$33.13 for the Proposition 20 apportionment. Lottery is funded based on current year Annual ADA but is initially allocated using the prior year’s Annual ADA multiplied by the factor of 1.04446.

A final lottery revenue adjustment is included in this fourth quarter apportionment. The adjustment reflects additional 2022–23 lottery revenue that is available for distribution. The additional revenue released for 2022–23 consist of \$2.36 per ADA is unrestricted lottery funding and \$2.60 per ADA is Proposition 20 lottery funding.
