



Know your costs

Here are your benefits at a glance:

When your doctor prescribes a medication, it will fall into one of these drug tiers. Tiers are a way of explaining how much your prescription will cost.

Tier 1: Generic, lowest-cost medications
Tier 2: Preferred brand names, low-cost medications
Tier 3: Non-preferred brand name medications (lower-cost options may be available)
Tier 4: Higher-cost medications (often includes specialty medications for conditions such as cancer, multiple sclerosis or rheumatoid arthritis)
